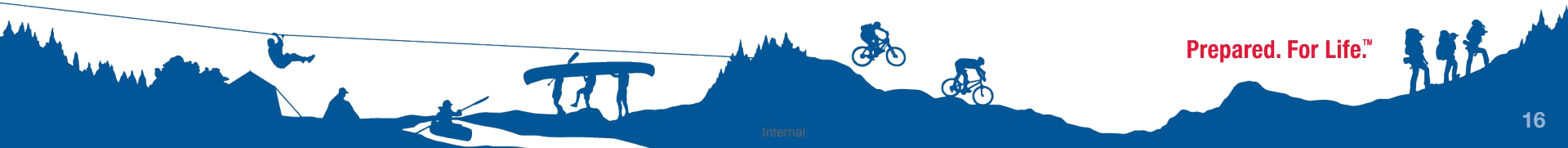

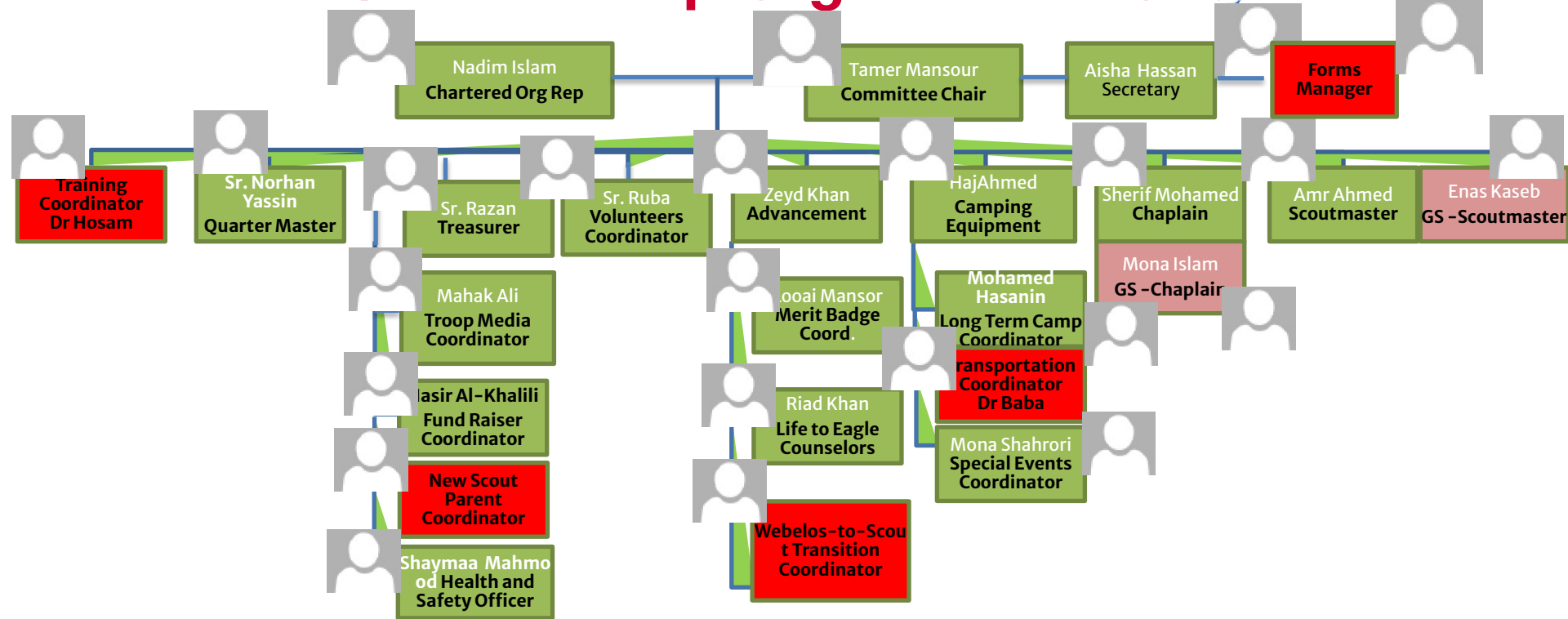


◆ Troop's Organization Chart

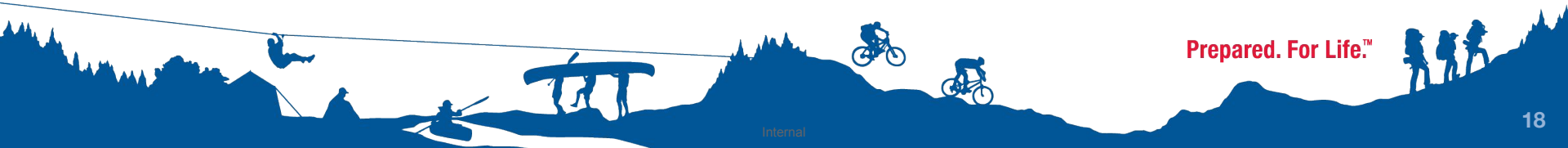

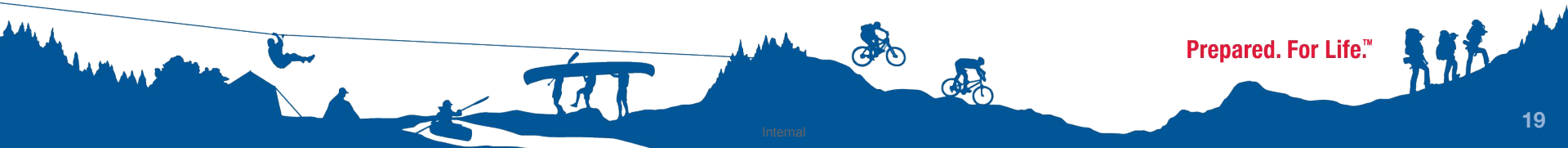

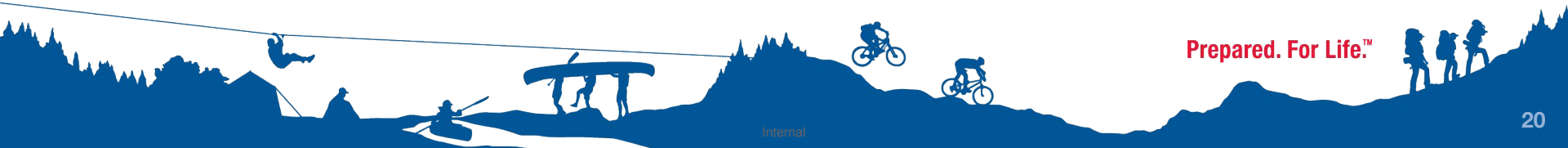

- If unable to attend a camping trip, coordinate transportation with your patrol or Assistant Scoutmaster to avoid unattended drop-offs.

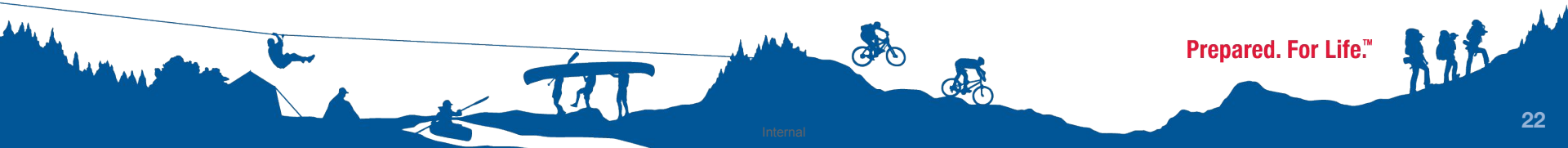

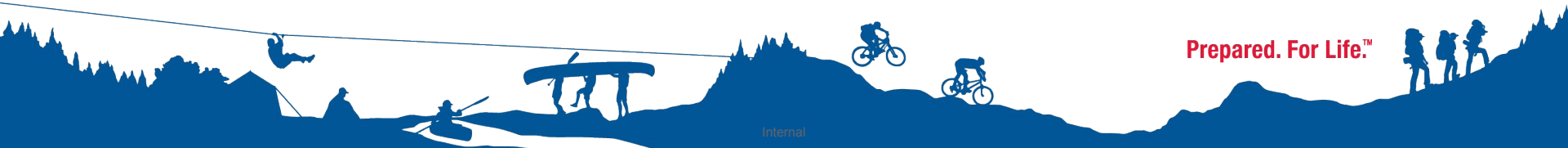
Troop Advancement Committee

2024 - 2025 Rules and Consequences

- Below 70% unexcused attendance at troop meetings will result in exclusion from camps.
- Proper Islamic attire and conduct required at all times.
- No wandering during troop meetings or camps
- Report any safety issues to an adult leader.
